Privacy Policy

It is The Mosaic Company's ("Mosaic" or "Mosaic's") policy to respect the privacy of its online visitors. We may also use this information, unless you request otherwise, to keep you updated about Mosaic's latest product announcements, and upcoming events. We also use personal information to help us improve our products, services, content and advertising, and for loss prevention and anti-fraud purposes.

We may also share your personally identifiable information as follows:

 At times Mosaic may make certain personal information available to strategic partners that work with Mosaic to provide products and services, or that help Mosaic market to customers. For example, our third-party service providers may include companies who provide services such as web site hosting and support, customer service, email and postal delivery of marketing materials, auditing, and other similar services.
